**Note to club secretaries** – It is the responsibility of the club to ensure that all players used on this team line are eligible to play in this competition. By signing the team lines the secretary or their authorised deputy confirms that they have checked the eligibility of all players named on this teamline. See rule 45 for eligibility details. Up to 3 triallists can be used in league matches up to and including the 1<sup>st</sup> March. Up to 3 trialists can be used in League Cup sectional games. A trialist can only play two games for a club. If a player is marked as a trialist but plays no part in the match it does not count as one of his two trial matches. Players must be signed and registered 48 hours before cup rounds and 14 days before semi-finals and finals. For league games a player can be signed and registered up to 2 hours prior to the kick off of the match, the player's registration form must be stamped by the general secretary or his deputy for that player to be eligible to played as a registered player on that day. Player's full name, address and postcode must be present if no player registration number is known otherwise player name and player registration number are all that are required, failure to meet these requirements will result in a team line infringement and possible fine or render a player ineligible. Triallists must have Date of Birth recorded on Teamline.
